Caring for a Pet



▲ It is important to walk your dog.

Do you have a pet? Many people like to keep a pet.

Pets are fun to play with.

But you need to look after them.

Pets need a warm place to sleep.

Many pets need **exercise** too.

Some pets need you to spend time with them.



▲ Some pets need more attention than others.

Some pets need more **care** than others.

A dog needs food and water every day.

Some dogs need to be brushed **regularly**.

All dogs need a bath now and again.

Cats need to be fed each day too.

But they clean their own fur.



▲ Lizards need a warm tank.

▲ Make sure to give your bird plenty of water.

Birds, lizards and hamsters are kept in a **cage** or tank.

Their bed should be cleaned regularly.

They might need **special** food too.

A lizard might need insects to eat.

A hamster might need a **wheel** for exercise.

A bird needs space to fly from time to time.



▲ Ponies need to be groomed regularly.

Some people keep bigger animals as pets.

A pony needs to be kept **outdoors**. It needs a field to **graze** in and lots of fresh water.

It needs a **stable** to stay in at night.

A pony needs lots of hay in winter too.

Looking after a pony is a big job!
