



Dear Parents and Girls,

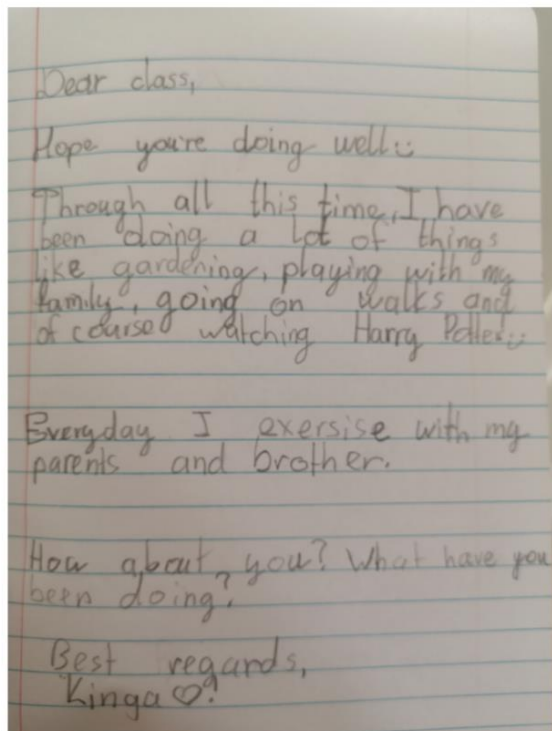

Dear class,

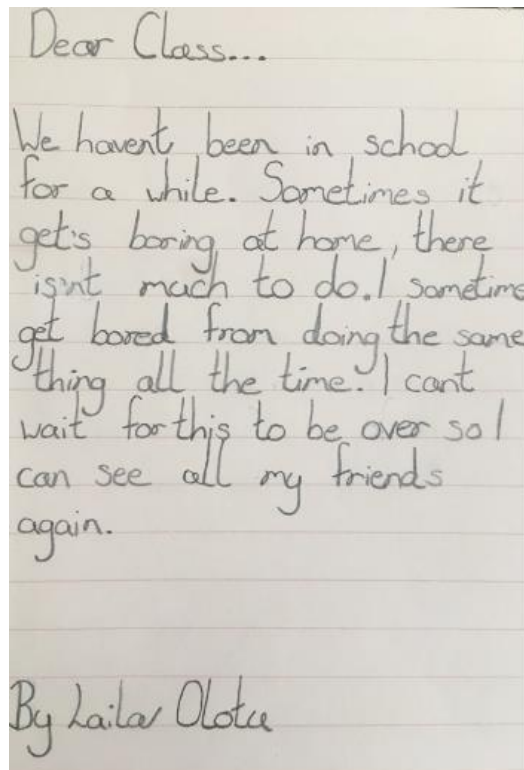
I am missing ye so much. I hope ye are all safe.

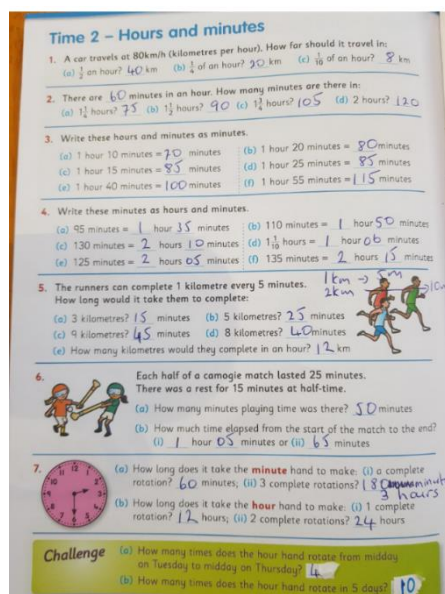
