

THE SUNFLOWER



The sunflower is one of the most popular summer flowers. Its bright yellow flower is easy to recognize. The sunflower grows from three to ten feet in height. The head of the sunflower can measure more than one foot across and produce up to one thousand seeds. The head of the sunflower follows the sun during the day.

The seeds of the sunflower can be used in many ways. The seeds of the sunflower are rich in protein. Many people enjoy eating sunflower seeds as a snack. Some types of sunflower seeds are used in birdseed. Sunflower oil is used in soaps and detergents. It is used in cooking. Sunflower oil is also being explored as a fuel source for diesel engines.

Argentina and regions of the former Soviet Union (including Russia) produce the most sunflower seeds in the world. Kansas, Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Texas produce the most sunflower seeds in the United States.

Most types of sunflower seeds must be planted each year. There are a few types that will come up from previous plantings. Many people plant sunflowers in their gardens to enjoy their beauty during the summer months. Sunflowers are delightful.

Paper Chase

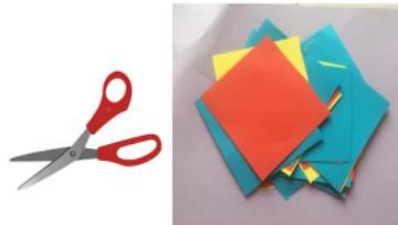
Paper chase is a game that can be played with two or more people. It involves the skill of coordination.

Equipment

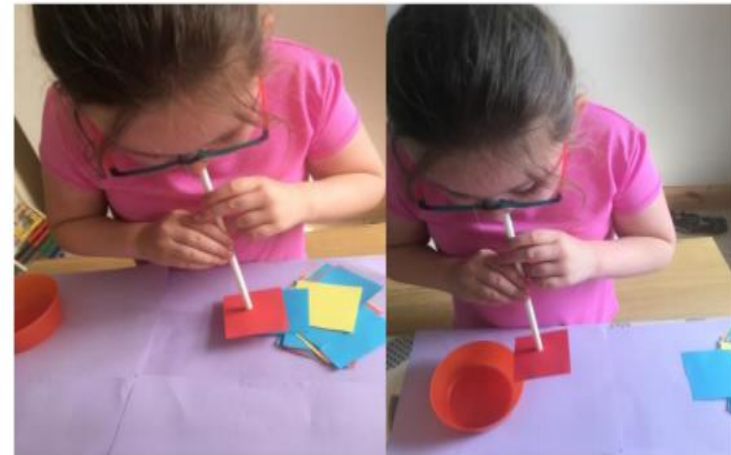
Scissors	Coloured Paper	Straw	Bowl
			

Method:

3. Using a straw, the participants have to suck on the paper to move the paper squares from their left to their right and into the bowl





4. The fastest participant to move all their paper squares wins!
